

Periodical Review November 2010 – No. 1

This report summarizes the most prominent events brought up in the Jihadi online forums in the second half of October 2010. Following are the main issues raised in this report:

- A new tape by Bin Laden, threatening France.
- Discussions on Jihadi forums continue surrounding Al-Qaeda's strategy.
- The "Islamic State of Iraq" organization threatens the Christian church in Egypt.
- Explanations on the forums on how to manufacture explosive charges that can go undetected through airport scanners.
- A new issue of the Jihadi "Al-Somood" magazine.
- Global Jihad organizations focus their attention on the Palestinian theater.
- An announcement declaring the opening of a new forum called "Al-Mushtaqun Ila Al-Jannah".

New publications

Ideology

- The various Jihadi forums reported on a new audio tape by Osama bin Laden, this time addressing the French people. The tape was broadcast on the "Al-Jazeera" station on October 27th 2010. In the tape, Bin Laden explained that the abduction of the five Frenchmen in Niger in mid-September 2010¹ was in response to the French oppression of the Islamic nation. Bin Laden said on the tape that his organization reserves the right to use force to push the French forces out of Afghanistan, just as France is "entitled" to ban Muslim women from wearing a veil.²

It should be noted that at the beginning of October 2010, two audio tapes by Bin Laden were published within a 24 hour period, in which he referred to the natural disaster that befell Pakistan over the previous months.³

Following Bin Laden's statements, a senior surfer at the "Shabakat Al-Mujahideen Al-Electroniya" forum (Al-Mojahden Electronic Network) called "Asad Al-Islam" (the Lion of Islam) published his response, stressing that Bin Laden's repeated appearances prove that he is still "alive and kicking". Furthermore, despite the certain achievements of the Coalition Forces in Afghanistan, Al-Qaeda still blossoms in other regions around the world, such as Spain and Britain in Europe, Iraq, the Arabian Peninsula and the Maghreb.⁴



- The "As-Sahab" institute published the statements of Adam Yahye Gadahn, under the heading "The Arabs and the Muslims: between the Conferences of Desertion and the Individual Duty of Jihad."⁵
- The website of the Jordanian Salafi Sheikh Abu Muhammad Al-Maqdisi, "Minbar Al-Tawhid wal-Jihad", published a 156-page book titled "The Al-Wasatia thieves: A response to the Al-Wasatia Conference in Nouakchott", by Sheikh Abu Al-Mundhir Al-Shanqiti.⁶

The writer complains of the attempts by Muslim religious clerics to market a model of Islam advocating middle ground and opposing the use of violence, called "Al-Wasatia". According to him, it is a fabrication and a collection of lies. The current essay, according to him, is meant to disprove the assertions and prove that there is such a thing as "Wasati" Islam, as expressed recently at the convention held in the Mauritanian capital.

- The "Al-Nur" Jihadi media institute published an 18-page booklet titled "The closing down of the Salafi Islamic channels: a new chapter in the battle of the governments of deception against Islam", by Sheikh Abu Al-Muhtasab Al-Ghazawi Al-Maqdisi, a Salafi-Jihadi Sheikh, apparently of Palestinian origin. The author criticizes the Egyptian government's decision to shut down a series of Salafi channels operating in the country, and claims that the reason they were closed down is due to the subversive nature of the Shiites, the seculars and especially the Christians, to limit the influence of Islam in the country.⁷
- The "Al-Ma'asada" Jihadi propaganda institute published a booklet titled "The essence of things: Part one" (27 pages long), by Sheikh Abu Saed Al-Amili.⁸ The essay discusses the path of true faith.
- The "Ansar Dawlat Al-Iraq Islamiya" Jihadi forum (the Supporters of the Islamic state of Iraq) published a video titled "A barbaric torture of Muslim Sheikhs by the collaborating Pakistani Army".
- The "Al-Ma'asada" Jihadi media institute, described as "the voice" of the "Shumukh Al-Islam" Jihadi forum, published a booklet titled "The reality of Jihadi propaganda and its role" (10 pages long) by Sheikh Abu Saed Al-Amili.⁹
- The "Al-Ma'asada" Jihadi media institute, described as "the voice" of the "Shumukh Al-Islam" Jihadi forum, published a collection of poems titled "Monotheists who helped their religion" (50 pages long) by the "Al-Qaeda poet", Muhammad Al-Zuheiri.¹⁰

In 2007, Al-Zuheiri, a Jordanian resident and member of the Engineers' Syndicate in Jordan, was accused by the Jordanian Military Court of offending the honor of the Jordanian King by publishing a "Qasida" on one of the Jihadi forums praising the Al-Qaeda leaders. He was sentenced to a year and a half in prison. Beginning in 2005, he used to surf Jihadi forums, and has since then become an active member many of them, publishing many "Qasidas" praising Osama bin Laden, Abu Musab Al-Zarqawi and more, until he gained the title "Al-Qaeda's poet".¹¹

Strategy

- A senior surfer at the "Shabakat Al-Mujahideen Al-Electroniya" forum (Al-Mojahden Electronic Network) called "Abu Atiyah", posted some correspondence under the heading "Al-Qaeda's strategy, the recent achievements and expectations of the future". It should be noted that this correspondence followed previous correspondence on the matter of Al-Qaeda's strategy, posted by a surfer called "Ubada bin Al-Samit" on the "Shumukh Al-Islam" forum at the beginning of October 2010.¹²
- The "Al-Furqan" Jihadi media institute operating on behalf of the Islamic State of Iraq published an audio tape from the "Istishhadiyun Brigade Soldiers to the Christians in Egypt". In the tape, the Islamic State of Iraq organization threatens to carry out terrorist attacks against the Christians in Egypt following the arrest of Muslim women by the Egyptian church, as per the organization's claims.¹³ The background to these threats is Kamilia Shehata's

conversion to Islam – she was a member of the Coptic Church and according to the Islamic State of Iraq, the church threatened to harm her after the conversion.¹⁴

In addition to the audio tape, the “Ministry of War of the Islamic State of Iraq” gave a 48-hour ultimatum to the Egyptian church to release the female Muslim prisoners they are holding.¹⁵

- The Jihadi “Nukhbat Al-'Ilam Al-Jihadi” media group published a fourth publicity video clip as part of the publicity campaign “Equip Us”. The video, like the previous ones, addresses the Muslims asking them to help the Jihad and the Mujahideen with money and financing, so as to fulfill the commandment of “Jihad with funds” (Al-Jihad bil-Mal). This publication is in response to the appeal of Sheikh Mustafa Abu Al-Yazid - the Al-Qaeda leader in Afghanistan and the man responsible for the organization’s finances. He was killed in May 2010, but several weeks before his death he asked for funds to help the Mujahideen.¹⁶



- The "Al-Ansar" media institute published the message "To you my brother the Mujahid – we shall win!". The message is on behalf of the "Jama'at Ansar Al-Islam" (the Ansar Al-Islam Group) in Iraq.

The message contains encouragement for the Mujahideen, stating: "Our victory will arrive and Iraq, Afghanistan, Chechnya, Somalia and all of the Muslim countries will be liberated. Furthermore, the flag 'there is no God but Allah' will be hoisted over the American White House".

The message warns against the "Devil's seductions" in the heart of the Mujahid, diverting him from the truth and intimidating him in the face of the heretics and their strength. It calls on the Mujahideen to adhere to the path of Jihad despite the obstacles and difficulties, and explains that victory is slow and the casualties and pain will be doubled, but without a doubt victory will arrive.

The message contains an admission of the enemy's power: "The devil's soldiers have the fastest aircrafts, the strongest APC's (armored personnel carrier), the most impervious tanks and the newest machine guns", but this admission does not diminish from the confidence in the power of Allah who has given "his soldiers" the power "to bring down these airplanes, burn the Hummers and blow up the tanks".¹⁷

Instructional and Guidance Publications

- An active surfer on the "Military preparation" chat room on the Jihadi "Shabakat Al-Mujahideen Al-Electroniya" forum (Al-Mojahden Electronic Network) posted correspondence on Semtex. According to him, the airport screening machines in the West make it difficult to take explosives onto airplanes, but Semtex, which is very powerful, can be smuggled in. However, he does not explain how this material can be smuggled.

In the correspondence he explains that this material can be made into a bomb and demonstrates this with illustrations. He asks other surfers that have the knowledge on how to manufacture a bomb from this material, to publish it, and finally provides a link to a short YouTube video showing an experimental explosion of 200 grams of Semtex on board a 747 Boeing aircraft. The surfers on the forum acquiesce to his request and post a "recipe" for preparing a bomb using Semtex.¹⁸




- A surfer on the Jihadi "Shabakat Al-Mujahideen Al-Electroniya" forum (Al-Mojahden Electronic Network) published instructions on how to prepare a "toxic letter".¹⁹

- The "Al-Fajr" Jihadi media institute published the 14th audio segment called "The security of finances – security in purchasing weapons and transporting them and the security in instructions". This segment was published as part of the series of publications called "The industry of terrorism: a course in security and intelligence".²⁰



- One of the surfers at the "Shumukh Al-Islam" Jihadi forum posted a 22-page booklet titled "The genius in home made explosives" accompanied by illustrations.²¹



Promoting the Myth of the Shahid

- The "As-Sahab" Jihadi media institute published a video clip titled "The scent of heaven: Part five".²² The video focuses on several Jihad commanders in the Afghan Jihad theater, who planned and led the suicide attacks against the "enemy forces". These included Sheikh Abu Abd Al-Rahman Al-Madani, who

went to Afghanistan in 1988 and trained at an Al-Qaeda training camp. Upon the U.S invasion of Afghanistan, he went to Saudi Arabia to help his Mujahideen brothers in the Arabian Peninsula. In 2005 he returned to his friends in the Afghan theater, and "took part in planning the terrorist attacks and in participating in them". He was killed in 2007.

- The "As-Sahab" Jihadi media institute published a video titled "The Khorasan horseman: the Lion Abu Jaafar Al-Kuwaiti". The video focuses on the suicide attack carried out by Abu Jaafar Al-Kuwaiti, an Al-Qaeda member who used a car bomb which exploded at the Margha Base, a joint military base for the U.S and Afghan Army forces located in the Paktika province in Afghanistan. According to Al-Qaeda, this terrorist attack resulted in the death of 15 Afghan soldiers and 5 soldiers from the Coalition Forces.²³




- The "Al-Malahem" institute published a collection of poems titled "Together with the people of eternity".²⁴

Magazines

- A new issue (no. 53) was published of the Jihadi "Al-Somood" magazine published on behalf of the Taliban organization in Afghanistan. Amongst the subjects discussed in this issue, reference is made to the groups behind the U.S. decision to disseminate reports on the negotiations between the Karzai government and the leadership of the Islamic Emirate in Afghanistan; an interview with Najib Allah Haqani, in charge of the military activity in the Lughman Province (in eastern Afghanistan); short biographies of the shahids who fought in the ranks of the Taliban; a detailing of the main battles between the Taliban and the Coalition Forces and the Afghan Army, and other issues.²⁵

Reports from the field

Afghanistan - Pakistan

- The "Shumukh Al-Islam" Jihadi forum published photographs under the heading "The Islamic State of Pakistan: the Mujahideen attack a Japanese Consulate vehicle in the city of Karachi in Pakistan".²⁶



- The "Shabakat Al-Mujahideen Al-Electroniya" Jihadi forum (Al-Mojahden Electronic Network) reported that the Taliban attacked a U.N. building in western Afghanistan on October 23rd 2010.²⁷

Iraq

- The "Islamic State of Iraq" (ISI) organization published an announcement titled "The new claims of the Green Zone government are false". The announcement accuses the Iraqi government security forces of spreading rumors that they have succeeded in apprehending those behind some of the terrorist attacks carried out recently in Baghdad.²⁸

- The "Islamic State of Iraq" organization published an announcement on "A number of documented military activities of the security units in the Baghdad Province". The announcement lists 32 terrorist attacks carried out by members of the "Islamic State of Iraq" against various targets in Baghdad during the recent month of Ramadan, such as the assassinations of Iraq security personnel, detonation of roadside charges etc.²⁹

The Arabian Peninsula

- During the second half of October 2010 there weren't many reports from this arena. At the end of the month the affair of the "Explosives packages" from Yemen occurred, covered extensively in the Arab and global media. In their reporting of the issue, the Jihadi forums relied on reports from the foreign media. The Maghreb

- The "Shabakat Al-Mujahideen Al-Electroniya" Jihadi forum (Al-Mojahden Electronic Network) posted an article published by "The Daily Telegraph" newspaper, claiming that Al-Qaeda is operating to reinforce its presence in five countries in North Africa and the Middle East – Mauritania, Niger, Mali, Somalia and Yemen – through support of the local organizations.³⁰

The Al-Sham region

- A publication on behalf of the "Jund Al-Tawhid" at the "Islamic Emirate of Gaza": "And the Journey has begun – rocket launching on Jewish settlements that were taken away".³¹ It should be noted that even though Abu Al-Nur Al-Maqdisi declared the founding of the Islamic Emirate of Gaza in August 2009, the use of this term was not at all prevalent in Jihadi publications and statements made by Jihad leaders. The use of the term by the "Jund Al-Tawhid" organization, and sometimes of the term "the Islamic Emirate of Palestine", is relatively new and maybe shows a concentrated effort made by global Jihad organizations in the Palestinian theater, or of an authorization given by Al-Qaeda's general leadership to call this region an Islamic emirate. In the announcement made by the "Jund Al-Tawhid at the Islamic Emirate of Palestine", the organization explains why it has chosen this new name. The organization mentions that it wishes to operate under a flag and an Amir in Palestine, or under an Amir that will be appointed instead of Abu Al-Nur Al-Maqdisi, who was assassinated by Hamas in August 2009. The organization further explains that there are many "brothers" who operate on their own and all of them are waiting for the appointment of a new Amir, and that is why the "Jund Al-Tawhid" organization has declared its new name through this publication.³²

- The "Jama'at Al-Tawhid wal-Jihad", one of the organizations operating in the Gaza Strip, published an announcement on the "Repulsive campaign against the people of Unitarianism/Monotheism in Gaza; wishing to extinguish the light of Allah". In the announcement, the group condemns the campaign led by the Hamas movement against the followers of the Salafi movement in the Gaza Strip, which has manifested itself in arrests, kidnappings, torture and so forth.³³
- A representative of the "Al-Nur" Jihadi institute on the "Shumukh Al-Islam" Jihadi forum posted a message to the forum, containing a eulogy for two shahids called Muhammad Husham Zakut and Mahmud Jaber Washah. The two were members of the "Army of Islam", a Palestinian Jihadi Salafi group, and were killed by the Israeli air force.³⁴
- A surfer on the "Shabakat Al-Mujahideen Al-Electroniya" Jihadi forum (Al-Mojahden Electronic Network) published "A plan for the liberation of Palestine". The surfer addressed the "Arabs of 1948" encouraging them to act for the liberation of Palestine, or to wear Israel down.³⁵
- A senior surfer at the "Shabakat Al-Mujahideen Al-Electroniya" Jihadi forum (Al-Mojahden Electronic Network) reported that Syrian Intelligence has carried out a series of arrests against Islamists in the city of Hums.³⁶

Egypt

- The issue of the conversion to Islam of the Coptic girl Kamilia Shehata in Egypt refuses to die down.³⁷ One of the surfers at the "Shumukh Al-Islam" Jihadi forum posted an article on the matter under the heading "Al-Qaeda calls on the Muslims to help Kamilia Shehata; has Jihad in Egypt already begun?"

According to the surfer the subject of Shehata's conversion has succeeded in shocking the Egyptian authorities and the Coptic Church. According to him, the various statements made by prominent figures in the Jihad campaign to help Shehata, such as Bin Laden himself in his speech from the beginning of October 2010 which was about helping "the brothers in Pakistan",³⁸ makes one wonder whether Al-Qaeda intends to carry out a terrorist attack in Egypt and whether Shehata heralds a new phase of Jihad on Egyptian soil?

At the end, the surfer concludes with a warning directed towards the Christian population in Egypt: "Oh Christians in Egypt just you wait, Al-Qaeda has declared a merciless war on you... Wait".³⁹

Following these events the "Hanein" Jihadi forum published a detailed report, containing statistical data, on the Christianization process in Egypt.⁴⁰

- One of the surfers on the "Shumukh Al-Islam" Jihadi forum praised the fearlessness of the youth in Egypt for hoisting the flag of the "Islamic State of

Iraq" for the first time in Egypt, in the face of the Egyptian security forces, which is "the same flag waved by Jihadists in Somalia, Yemen and Gaza".⁴¹



Africa

- A discussion on the reports of the possible change in leadership in Somalia's "Al-Shabab Al-Mujahideen" was conducted on the Islamic Awakening forum. Questions were asked on the legitimacy of Al-Qaeda's interference in the local management of the Somali organization.⁴²
- The "Al-Shabab Al-Mujahideen" held a military parade on October 21st 2010, with the participation of the graduates of the Special Forces graduating class belonging to the reserve forces in Banader. Senior members from the movement participated in the parade and various anti-aircraft weaponry, as well as anti-tank and light weapons were presented. The brigade was named after Mustafa Abu Al-Yazid who was killed in May 2010. Other parades took place elsewhere, some of them near the border with Ethiopia.⁴³

This discussion stemmed from the reports in the Arab media and the denials issued by the no. 2 man in the "Al-Shabab Al-Mujahideen" movement regarding disagreements amongst the organization's leadership.⁴⁴

- The "Al-Kataib" Jihadi media institute, serving as the mouthpiece for the "Al-Shabab Al-Mujahideen" movement, published an announcement titled "The break-in at the Uganda Forces' military post". According to the announcement, on October 23rd 2010 a group belonging to the "Sheikh Mustafa Abu Al-Yazid Brigade" broke into a military post belonging to the Ugandan Forces in Mogadishu. Following violent conflicts and exchange of fire, the Mujahideen killed a great number of Ugandan soldiers and carried out looting.⁴⁵

- The "Al-Kataib" Jihadi media institute, which serves as the mouthpiece for the "Al-Shabab Al-Mujahideen" movement, published an announcement titled: "An ambush on an aid convoy for the enemy in the region of El-Gal". According to the announcement, on October 22nd 2010 a group of Mujahideen ambushed a military convoy carrying the weapons and equipment of the "enemy". This ambush was successful as three vehicles were blown up by landmines placed on the road by the Mujahideen. Another convoy was sent by the Ethiopian forces to assist the first one, but it too got caught in the Mujahideen's ambush.⁴⁶
- On October 25th 2010 the "Boko Haram" group in Nigeria attacked a police station in the north of the country.⁴⁷
- The "Shabakat Al-Mujahideen Al-Electroniya" Jihadi forum (Al-Mojahden Electronic Network) reported that a surfer from the "Al-Faloja" forum was killed in Mogadishu.⁴⁸

The West and the rest of the world

- A surfer on the "Shabakat Al-Mujahideen Al-Electroniya" Jihadi forum (Al-Mojahden Electronic Network) called for the media to be used to inflame tensions amongst the people in France, probably following the demonstrations surrounding the new pension law, so as to try and create a civil war in the country which will eventually lead to the retreat of the French forces from Afghanistan.⁴⁹
- The "Hanein" Jihadi forum reported that Sheikh Abu Sharif, spokesperson of the "Asbat Al-Ansar" organization in Lebanon which is suspected of having

ties with Al-Qaeda, has threatened Bulgaria because it sent soldiers to participate in the occupation of Iraq and Afghanistan.⁵⁰

General reports

- The "Shumukh Al-Islam" Jihadi forum published an announcement on the opening of the "Shumukh Al-Islam College of Propaganda". The forum bemoaned the ongoing trend of disinformation against the Mujahideen, led by the "enemy's" propaganda, whether it is the West or the Arab leaders, using the various media channels. According to the forum, the internet is the only medium where the Mujahideen can leverage their propaganda and present the truth as it is. Following this, the forum decided "for the first time in the history of Jihadi propaganda to launch a college that specializes in the teaching of propaganda materials of Jihad supporters at the hand of experts, in accordance with an advanced curriculum that is meant to raise the level of the blessed propaganda [...] so that the voice of truth reaches all of this nation's sons and all of the nations on the planet."

The forum asks all of those helping Jihad, and especially those in the propaganda institutes, to join the "Shumukh Al-Islam College of Propaganda" and to contribute to the Jihadi propaganda effort. The terms and the college staff will be as follows:⁵¹

- a. The teaching language at the college shall be Arabic alone.
- b. The school period shall be two years, over four semesters.
- c. Each semester shall be five months long and will be comprised of 30 lectures.

- d. The expert lecturer in every field will give a lecture every five days. Furthermore, he will have to hold a discussion with the students before each class. "Therefore, all of the student brothers must attend and absence without informing the college administration is forbidden".
- e. A student that does not answer the lecturer's questions shall be considered absent.
- f. Any student missing for three lectures without having received permission to do so from the college administration shall be deemed as having dropped out of college.
- g. The student shall be evaluated based on the quality of his participation and activity.
- h. College registration will end on October 31st 2010.
- i. School will begin on November 2nd 2010.

According to the forum, anyone wishing to join the college must write an application to that effect or inform the administration at the "Complaints Department", and he will then be contacted. Furthermore, the same students that register will receive permission to operate in the College of Propaganda.



- A message to all the Muslim religious clerics from a surfer fearing the arrival of the "heretic enemy" into Islam to destroy the foundations of Islam and religious faith. He bemoans the loss of Andalus, China, Iran, India, Iraq,

Palestine and other Muslim countries. He urges, to the point of pleading, the Sunni religious clerics to declare a general Jihad and send Mujahideen from Islamic countries to purge the lands conquered by the heretics.⁵²

- A surfer on the "Al-Jahafil" forum calls on the Mujahideen and their supporters in Afghanistan, Pakistan and Iraq to use the documents on the "Wikileaks" website pertaining to these countries. He mentions, for example, that the website contains the names of 60,000 Iraqi spies. He calls on the Mujahideen to also fight the U.S in Pakistan, as it is conquering the country through its aircraft, CIA agents and agents within the Pakistani government.⁵³ Another surfer calls on the Mujahideen in Yemen to kill the religious clerics operating under the patronage of the government, as they call on their websites for the elimination of the Mujahideen.⁵⁴
- One of the surfers on the "Shumukh Al-Islam" Jihadi forum explains to the surfers how one can contact the "Al-Qaeda in the Arabian Peninsula" organization using encryption software called "Asrar Al-Mujahideen" (Secrets of the Mujahideen). According to him, there is some difficulty in entering the correct code in the encryption program, included in issue no. 11 of the Jihadi "Sada Al-Malahem" magazine on page 68, as well as in issue no. 12 of the same magazine, on page 2. In order to facilitate the process for the surfers, the surfer posted the code on the forum.⁵⁵

Miscellaneous

- An announcement of the opening of a new Jihadi forum called "Al-Mushtaqun Ila Al-Jannah" meant to assist Jihad and the Mujahideen. It should be noted that up until February 2010 there was a Jihadi magazine published under the same name. The forum manager called for new surfers to join, as well as creative writers, every representative of the free Jihadi media networks and anyone with experience in Jihad media. The forum also opened chat rooms in Pashtu and Persian.⁵⁷

All the while, the new-old forum called "Shabakat Al-Tawhid Al-Islamiya" (Al-Tawhid Islamic Network) started operating again, after having been temporarily closed down following the altercation with the "Al-Faloja" forum.⁵⁸ The forum explains the reasons for its closing down for a period of several months – the alleged "theft" of designs belonging to the "Al-Faloja" forum and its claims against the person in charge of the "Al-Tawhid" forum that he is trying to promote his own forum at the expense of "Al-Faloja" and other forums. Only after an investigation of the situation has been made and after it has been concluded that there was no wrongdoing, it was decided that the "Al-Tawhid" forum should be reopened.⁵⁹
